# English

This half term, we will be reading and compare alternative versions of traditional stories, discussing opposing characters. We will then plan and write alternative traditional stories of our own. We will continue to work on spellings and comprehension skills as well as punctuation and grammar rules in more detail. We are really focusing on handwriting this term- please help your child to work on this at home if you can by giving your child opportunities to write e.g. thank you letters from Christmas, weekly diary, postcard when they are on holiday, shopping lists etc. Look out for your child's writing targets- they are highlighted on a copy of the Year 2 interim assessment grids so that you can see what your child will be working on in school over the next two terms.

#### Maths




We will be looking at fractions in relation to length, shape and number including  $^{1}/_{3}$ ,  $^{1}/_{4}$ ,  $^{2}/_{4}$  and  $^{3}/_{4}$ . We will also be looking at time; comparing and sequencing intervals of time and telling the time. We will continue to work on place value with addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

#### Science



We will start the half term with a mini topic on materials, looking at how materials are used and how they can be changed. We will then look at forces and movement through our topic of 'Terrific Tales'. We will compare how things move on different surfaces and we will ask questions, devise simple tests and make predictions.

In Computing we will read and reply to emails and compose our own emails. We will discuss e-safety. We will use information gained from our emails to compile a simple database.

As well as all this there will be gymnastics, music, outdoor PE, RE, circle time, role play activities, show and tell, learning platform and Mymaths activities and lots more ......
