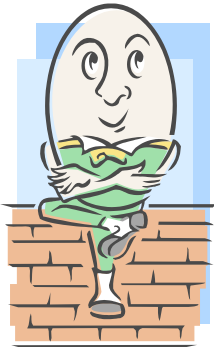


Reception Newsletter
