Phonics

Your child has started to bring home sound sheets linked to the sounds we are learning in class. Please look through these with your child and practise forming the letters by following the arrows on the guides.

Help your child to spot the letters in words around you (shops, food packets, newspapers etc) as this will help them with their early reading skills.

Please keep the sound book in your child's book bag every day.

It will finish in time for you to collect your children at the end of the school day. You are welcome to bring younger siblings to this but please bring something to keep them quietly entertained!
