



# Bikeability Cycle Training – Level 2

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Derby City Council's Cycle Derby Team has arranged a **Bikeability** cycle training course (Level 2) to be held at your child's school, during curriculum time on:

## Wc 6th November (6H) and 13<sup>th</sup> November (6MH) 2017

The objective of the course is to provide the pupil with the skills and knowledge to be able to make a trip by bike on quiet roads. The course will be provided by qualified instructors and will be carried out on guiet residential streets. All you have to do is complete this consent form and return it to the school 2 weeks prior to your training start date and Cycle Derby will do the rest.

Your child will need to bring their own bike which should be in good working order. We reserve the right to refuse to use a bike which is not in a safe condition. Bikes need to have:

- a. Two working brakes.
- b. Tyres in good condition and pumped up.
- c. Handlebars and seat not loose
