## Chronology of key events

- 1914 1918 WWI
- 1<sup>st</sup> September 1939 Hitler invades Poland.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> September 1939 Allies declare war on Germany.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> September 1939 Evacuation begins.
- January 1940 rationing begins.
- July 1940 Battle of Britain.
- September 1940 Start of the Blitz.
- 1942 American troops arrive to assist The Allies.
- 8<sup>th</sup> May 1945 VE Day
- 2<sup>nd</sup> September 1945 Japan surrenders (thus ending the War).
