Eid-ul-Fitr	A Muslim celebration that celebrates the end of Ramadan.
Jewish	A religion followed by Jewish people.
Shabbat	A day in which Jewish people believe their God rested.
Ritual	Something that is repeated in a religion
Passover	A Jewish celebration that honours freedom.
