
- To use the correct vocabulary to name parts of the body and to describe the changes that take place during puberty

| puberty | Puberty is the time when a boy or girl's body begins to develop and change as they become an adult. |
| menstruation | The correct term for the period when a female loses blood and tissue from her vagina. |
| vagina clitoris | Part of the female sexual organs |
| penis | Male sexual organ |
| Hormones | Hormones are the chemicals in the body that help us grow and function. Testosterone is the male sex hormone and oestrogen is the female sex hormone. |
| Personal hygiene | Keeping our bodies clean and fresh |
