Vocabulary you will know	
Cyberbullying	If someone makes you feel uncomfortable or upset online several times on purpose.
Strong password	A word or phrase, containing capital letters, lowercase letters, numbers or special characters that we keep private.
Online community	A group of people who communicate, play, post, share things online.
Safe adult	An adult you trust. This could be a parent or carer or your teacher.
Communication	Spoken or written messages between people.
Collaboration	To work together with others.
Privacy Settings	Ways to control who can see what you do online.
Digital Devices	An electronic device that can send, receive or store information.
Internet	A system that connects millions of computers worldwide.
World Wide Web	A collection of web pages found on the internet.
Unacceptable	Behaviour that is not pleasing or kind.
Acceptable	Behaviour that is pleasing and kind.
Keywords	Specific words that help us to find information.


