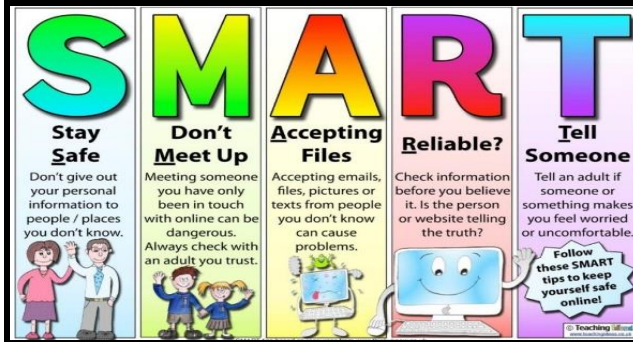




# Mickleover Primary School – Online Safety Knowledge Organiser

Vocabulary you will know...	
<b>Cyberbullying</b>	If someone makes you feel uncomfortable or upset online several times on purpose.
<b>Strong password</b>	A word or phrase, containing capital letters, lowercase letters, numbers or special characters that we keep private.
<b>Online community</b>	A group of people who communicate, play, post, share things online.
<b>Safe adult</b>	An adult you trust. This could be a parent or carer or your teacher.
<b>Communication</b>	Spoken or written messages between people.
<b>Collaboration</b>	To work together with others.
<b>Privacy Settings</b>	Ways to control who can see what you do online.
<b>Digital Devices</b>	An electronic device that can send, receive or store information.
<b>Internet</b>	A system that connects millions of computers worldwide.
<b>World Wide Web</b>	A collection of web pages found on the internet.
<b>Unacceptable</b>	Behaviour that is not pleasing or kind.
<b>Acceptable</b>	Behaviour that is pleasing and kind.
<b>Keywords</b>	Specific words that help us to find information.
