Cyber - bullying	Bullying using the internet or electronic devices
Trusted search engines	A means of searching the internet using a site that filters inappropriate content
Plagiarism	Presenting someone's work as your own, or copying the work of others without permission
Online community	A group of people that share a hobby, interest or belief online.
Digital citizenship	Using the internet responsibly and safely
Online profile	Information about yourself that is available online
