Settlement	A place where people choose to live.
Invasion	People who take over land and property of others.
Roundhouse	A Celtic home.
Resistance	Fighting against invaders.
Impact	Having an effect on something.
Legacy	Something that has had an impact and has been left behind.
Bias	A point of view that is particularly one sided
Empire	An area that has been invaded and controlled.
Revolt	An act against invasion.

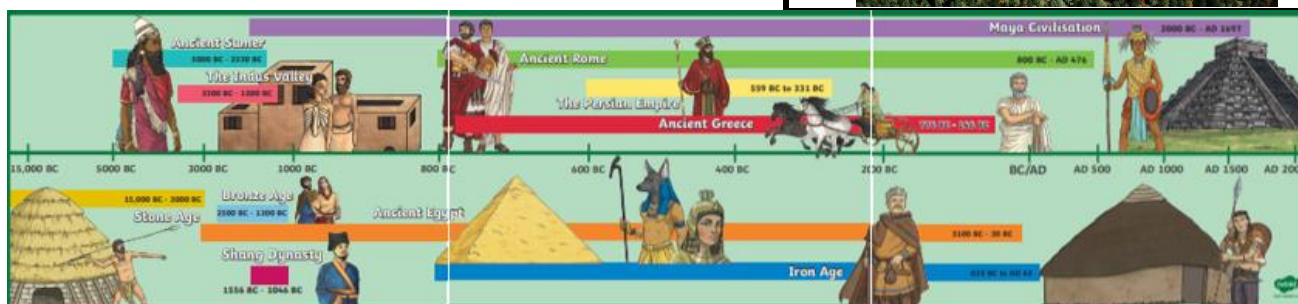
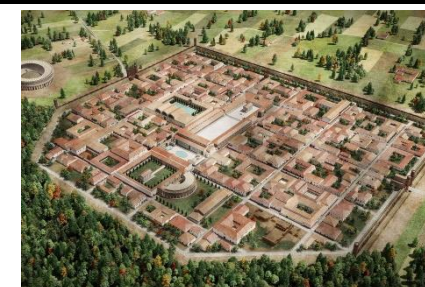
