Vocabulary you will know...

Diversity	Two or more differences between people in a group
Equity	Treating other's fairly by giving them what they need to be successful, even if those things are different.
Equality	Treating everyone in the same way regardless of their differences.
Stereotype	A fixed idea that many people have about a thing or a group that may be untrue or partly untrue
Respect	Acting in a way that shows you care about their feelings and well-being.
Discrimination	Treating a person or group of people unfairly and differently to other people.
Tolerance	Accepting others who are different from ourselves and treating them with kindness and fairly.

Key Questions

- What does it mean to be treated with **respect**?
- What are the consequences of **stereotyping** and **discrimination**?
- How could you challenge **discrimination** or **stereotyping** and make a difference?
- Why is having diverse images so important?
- How does it feel to be **discriminated** against?
- How can 'hate' affect people's lives and their communities?

Recognising their individuality and personal qualities.

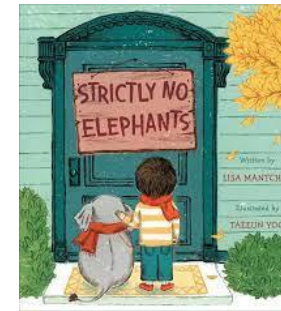
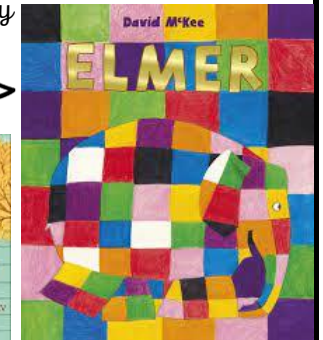
