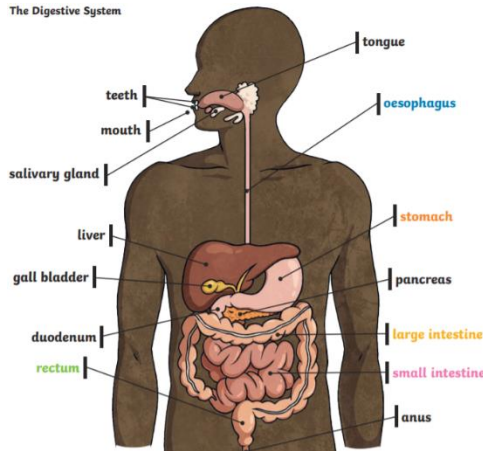

Decay	When something begins to rot away.

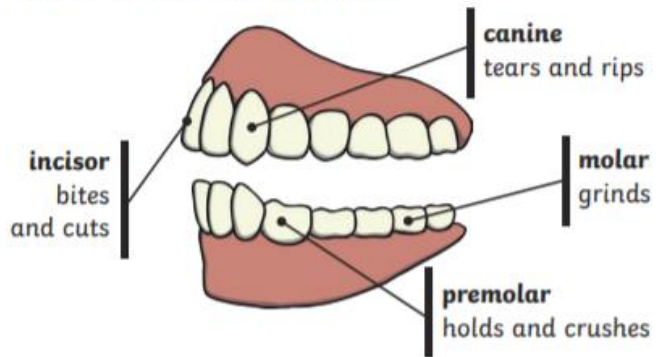
The Digestive System



Vocabulary you will know...

Digestion System	The system our body has for turning food into energy.
Oesophagus	A muscular tube which moves food from the mouth to the stomach.
Stomach	An organ where food is broken down.
Small intestine	Part of the intestine where nutrients are absorbed into the body.
Large intestine	Part of the intestine where water is absorbed from remaining food waste.
Anus	Where food waste leaves the body.

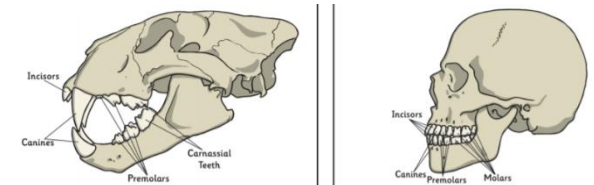
Human Teeth and Their Functions
