1. To show School Council the new play equipment purchased with the £400 budget

2. To decide how the play equipment should be shared with the children

School Council voted for Mrs Gerver to introduce the play equipment and expectations as to its use in one of her Monday assemblies.

Action: Lucas and Alfie to ask Mrs Gerver if she would consider the suggestion for one of her assemblies. Mrs Gerver has agreed to lead an assembly (29.4.24) on the play box equipment and link it to the following School Promises
