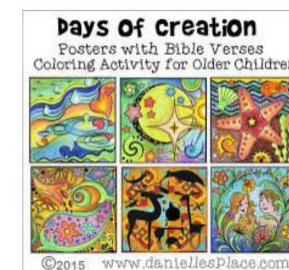


Key Learning
