



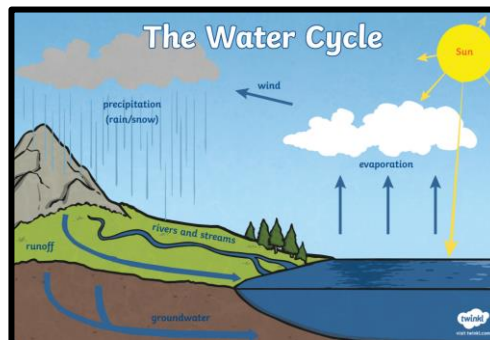

| <b>Geography</b>           | The science of the Earth's surface and all life on it.                                     |
| <b>Atlas</b>               | A book of maps.  |
| <b>Continent</b>           | A large solid area of land   |
| <b>Equator</b>             | An imaginary circle running round the centre of the earth.                                 |
| <b>Longitude</b>           | Invisible lines, the same distance apart – they circle the earth from North to South.      |
| <b>Latitude</b>            | Invisible lines, the same distance apart – they circle the earth from East to West.        |
| <b>Prime Meridian</b>      | An imaginary line which divides the earth into the eastern and western hemispheres.        |
| <b>Tropic of Cancer</b>    | An imaginary <b>latitude</b> line located above the <b>equator</b> .                       |
| <b>Tropic of Capricorn</b> | An imaginary <b>latitude</b> line located below the <b>equator</b> .                       |
| <b>Climate</b>             | Description of the average <b>weather</b> conditions in a place over 30 or so years.       |
| <b>Weather</b>             | Description of what the conditions are like in a particular place. E.g. wet, windy or dry. |



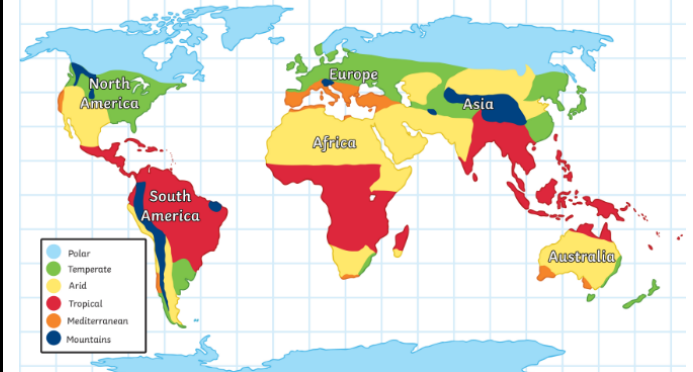
Key Learning
