Festivals	A day or period of celebration
Celebrations	An enjoyable event to mark a special time.
Passover	A Jewish religious festival to remember the escape of the Israelites from Egypt.
Believers	A person who believes in the existence or truth of something.
Community	People who make up a particular group.
Significant	Worthy of attention or important.
Easter	A Christian religious festival about the resurrection of Christ
Eid al Fitr	A Muslim religious festival marking the end of the fast of Ramandan.
Ramadan	The ninth month of the Muslim year where fasting is observed from dawn until dusk.
Temptation	The desire to do something wring or unwise.
Symbols	A mark, picture or word that represents an idea or object.
