Purpose of Post

• To provide efficient, effective and comprehensive cleaning support to the school.

Main duties and Responsibilities

- Emptying waste bins or similar receptacles, transporting waste material to designated collection points.
- Sweeping floors with brushes or dust control mops.
- Suction cleaning of carpeted areas and spot cleaning carpets.
- Mop hard floor areas with wet or damp mops.
- To use electrical equipment (vacuums, steam machines, buffers) in a safe and proper manner following all safety precautions including checking for damage to cables and plugs before commencing duties.
- Using electrically powered carpet shampooers and/or steam cleaner to clear up spills and 'accidents' as and when required and during summer holiday deep cleaning.
- To dust, damp wipe, sanitise, wash, polish furniture, ledges, windowsills, external surfaces of cupboards, radiators, shelves, and fitments and inside window pane cleaning.
- To replenish consumable material (soap, toilet rolls, paper towels, etc).
- To clean toilets, urinals, hand basins, and sinks, and drinking fountains.
- Cleaning with chemicals as instructed by the Supervisor, and ensure full compliance with COSHH regulations including correct dilution rates and usage as per data sheets
- To carry out wall washing in toilets to a height no greater than body height plus an arms extension from floor level once each half term and all other walls during the summer cleaning programme.
- Carry out wall washing and inside window pane cleaning to a height no greater than body height plus an arms extension from floor level.
- Comply with policies relating to equalities and environmental issues.
- To carry out any other reasonable duties within the overall function of the job as requested by the Site Manager.
- Adhere to health and safety regulations.
- Participate in the induction training of new employees and annual performance appraisal.
- To use any issued items of protective clothing at all required times and to ensure that Health and Safety regulations are adhered to
- You may also be required to undertake other duties commensurate with your grade in relation to a post of this nature.

This job description may be amended at any time following discussion between the Headteacher, members of staff and Chair of Governors and will be reviewed annually.
